




WEST ELEVATION - BUILDING 1 and BUILDING 2



1 TENANT | 2,000 SF BUILDING | 1,000 SF OUTDOOR SEATING | 40 PARKING STALLS





# FUTURE IRVINGTON BART STATION



The future Irvington BART Station will be located in the Irvington District at the intersection of Washington Boulevard and Osgood Road, approximately halfway between the existing Fremont BART Station and the Warm Springs/South Fremont BART Station.

Led by BART, the Design of the Irvington Station is advancing and approaching 90% completion. Construction documents are anticipated to be complete in Summer 2025. Subject to funding availability, and the acquisition of all necessary property, construction could start as early as mid-2026 with the station opening in 2031.
